Withdrawing from TCU

Withdrawing from TCU for the semester is a straight-forward process. It is important to understand that withdrawing affects the use of TCU resources, finances and academic progress. After processing a complete withdrawal, you are no longer considered a current student.

Please review the following actions you will need to take and departments to contact concerning the withdrawal process.

To Start
